Fees are \$40/camper. Scout leaders are free and additional adults are \$15 each. A \$50 non-refundable deposit is required to reserve space. Remaining balance is due no later than ONE MONTH prior to Camp-In. A health form for each scout (copy attached) must be completed. Please pay for Pack/Troop with one payment if possible.



Scout Camp-In 2010

We are excited about our upcoming Scout Sleepovers and hope you and your scouts will join us for an evening of fun and discovery. The following information should be helpful in planning for your night at SciWorks.

Registration and Balance Due:

A copy of the registration form is included. Please complete all areas and return it as soon as possible with at least a \$50 deposit. If you do not know the actual number of participants, you may estimate as closely as possible. Please try and not overestimate by too much; our events usually sell out and we would hate to turn scouts away unnecessarily. Provide us with accurate numbers as soon as you know them, but no later than **one month prior to your camp-in date**. You are responsible for payment of balance for all scouts **one month prior to your camp-in date** and any refund requests **two weeks prior to your camp-in date**. We request that you try to pay your Pack/Troop's balance with one payment if possible.

Health Forms:

A signed health form is necessary for all scouts, even those who are accompanied by a parent. Please make sure the pack/troop number is completed on each form. Health forms should be turned in the night of the sleepover or in advance **only** if all forms are completed.

What to bring:

Each person will need at least a sleeping bag and pillow, and whatever else you feel is necessary to be comfortable. Some campers change into sleeping attire, while others wear something comfortable in which they can remain all night. Although the museum will remain dimly lit throughout the night, flashlight will come in handy. We will be serving a snack during the evening. If you do bring snack items they may only be eaten in our **Food Works area**. Vending machines are available for snack items and soft drinks if desired until one hour before "Lights Out". Some people do get hot or cold, we suggest dressing in layers. SciWorks does not provide showers, cots, or air mattresses.

Check-in:

Check-in will begin at **5:30pm**. Orientation will begin at 6:45. Please try and arrive by **6:30pm**. **One adult** should be designated to check-in for your group. He/she will receive maps of the museum and information about workshop times, classroom assignments, snack schedule, and sleeping area. **If your group plans to arrive at staggered times please plan to have one adult remain near the check-in area to direct arriving campers to their designated area. Leaders should plan to arrive first.** Activities will begin at **7:00pm** sharp ...please enjoy museum exhibits until that time.

Friday Evening:

The camp-in will consist of a scout workshop, snack time, museum exhibit free time, and a chance to view a planetarium show and "Science Adventure" program. An itinerary indicating your time for participating in each activity will be provided at check-in. Snacks consist of two pieces of pizza (cheese and pepperoni) with drink. Snack is not served until mid-evening so please make sure campers eat dinner before arriving. After 4:00pm our main phone number will be rolled into voicemail. If there is an emergency and someone from your pack/troop must be reached, our night number is **336/767-6569**. This number will ring throughout the museum; please allow a few moments for someone to answer as we are all involved with camp-in activities.

Saturday Morning:

Coffee will be available in our snack area beginning at 7:00am for those ADULTS needing to jump-start their morning. A continental breakfast will be provided for all participants; check your itinerary at check-in for exact times. After breakfast, our Environmental Park (barnyard, deer, otter, waterfowl) will be open at 9:00am. The camp-in will end at 9:30am. **Don't forget to stop by the registration desk on your way out to complete an evaluation form and get your SciWorks Scout Camp-In patches.** Scouts will also have an opportunity to visit the SciWorks Science Shop!
